



Fellowship in Clinical Endodontics

- This Fellowship course is designed for **2months**
- It is a Clinical Programme which runs daily from **10am to 5 pm except sunday.**
- Initial days is for Lectures, Demonstrations, thorough discussions followed by Hands-on on extracted teeth.
- Case discussion and comprehensive treatment plan for each patient.
- Each fellow is allowed to work on patients for minimum of **20 root canal treatments, followed by 10 crown preparations.**

- Fellows have a provision of latest well equipped radiovisiography(RVG) which allows minimal radiation & enhanced digital image, rotary systems and usage of apex locator
